Respect Is Always Important.

1. Respect God

- Come to church with a good attitude and heart to learn about God.
- Respect the church Sanctuary as Holy and the Bible as God's Word.
- Be quiet when teachers or other students pray.

2. Respect others

AWANA teachers

- Pay attention to the teachers during AWANA.
- Follow the teachers' guidance and directions during council, game, and handbook time.

AWANA students

- No teasing or bullying
- No making fun of others
- Respect others' feelings
- Always use kind and encouraging words

Remember:

- When you listen to people, people will listen to you.
- When you talk nicely, people will talk nicely to you.

3. Respect the shared space

- Take care and take responsibility of your own belongings.
- No food during AWANA.
- Do not use equipment (musical instruments, piano, audio/visual equipment) without permission.
- Do not remove things from where they belong.
- Do not draw on walls.
- Do not draw on whiteboards unless instructed by teachers.
- Take good care of the church property.
- Keep all places tidy and clean.
- Do not run in the church hallways or on the stairs.

4. Seek help

- If you feel someone is bullying you, seek help from the teachers.
- Talk to the teachers if there are relationship issues with other kids.
- If you do not understand homework questions, ask the teachers or your parents.

Remember:

- Your teachers and parents cannot help if they don't know what is happening, and they cannot know unless you tell them.
