

**Scripture: Matthew 9:1-8 (NASB)**

<sup>1</sup> Getting into a boat, Jesus crossed over the sea and came to His own city.

<sup>2</sup> And they brought to Him a paralytic lying on a bed. Seeing their faith, Jesus said to the paralytic, "Take courage, son; your sins are forgiven."

<sup>3</sup> And some of the scribes said to themselves, "This fellow blasphemes." <sup>4</sup> And Jesus knowing their thoughts said, "Why are you thinking evil in your hearts? <sup>5</sup> "Which is easier, to say, 'Your sins are forgiven,' or to say, 'Get up, and walk'?

<sup>6</sup> "But so that you may know that the Son of Man has authority on earth to forgive sins"—then He said to the paralytic, "Get up, pick up your bed and go home." <sup>7</sup> And he got up and went home.

## Application for GBC 2026 Parking Permit

GBC now is now open parking applications. All GBC members who regularly attend our services can apply until February 15.

Application forms are available at the front desk. All the applications must be reviewed and approved by a pastoral staff. Please bring the NT\$200 application fee (and your old permit if to renew) to apply. Applicants can pick up their approved permit on the same day the following week.

### Special Notes:

1. After GBC's parking renovation was completed early January 2026, motorcycle and bicycle parking are no longer available.
2. Fire safety concerns, the passageways must remain clear. Parking spaces are on a first-come, first-served basis. Once the parking space is full, the entrance door will be closed. Due to limited parking spaces, members are encouraged to park in nearby parking spaces.
3. The parking permit must be posted (or hung) visibly on the front windshield. The parking permit is for personal use only and is not used by others.

## Reminders from GBC
